Are Champions required to attend?

No, Orientation is only mandatory for the students. But, if you would like to learn more about our nest we would love to have you!

How much interaction will I have with my student at Orientation?

Students and Champions will be separate for the majority of the program. There will be some overlap during mealtimes and at the welcome speeches, but otherwise groups will be completely separate.

Which program do you recommend?

Generally, we recommend the Fast Track program to Champions who have already sent a child or other dependent to college. This program covers basic information relevant to Westfield State student supporters and is only one day in length.

If this is your first time helping a student transition to college, we would encourage you to attend the Full Program. This comprehensive overnight program will provide you with an indepth look at the campus community, tools to support your student, and advice from other parents.
