This trauma-informed program is unique and small, Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT) and sensory skills based, and is family oriented and multidisciplinary. It is an opportunity to provide individual, family, group therapy and care coordination for emotionally and behaviorally challenged youth and their families in NCCF's residential treatment program. Primary caseload consists of males aged 12-20 in addition to some work with female adolescents and latency age youth. Predominantly campus-based work with some outreach and home-based work as well. Low caseload.

Requirements:

- Master's degree required; LICSW/LMHC preferred.
- Must possess strong organizational skills, and be self-motivated.
- Strong verbal & written communications skills, ability to establish clear professional boundaries and personal values.
- All candidates must complete and pass background record screening process and have a clean driving record without DUI/OUI. Reliable transportation is required.
