This lively community mental health clinic for children and adolescents ages 2-21 is looking for fulltime and part-time therapists (unlicensed or licensed) to work with youth who come for help with anxiety, struggles with mood, behavioral challenges, and trauma and loss. In addition to in-clinic sessions, there may also be opportunities to work with children in school settings. Working at least two evenings a week is required for fulltime clinicians. We offer weekly supervision towards licensure and are dedicated to dynamic clinical learning. Clinicians also have the use of a therapeutic playroom and, by the end of this summer, two rooms for sensory-based treatment.
