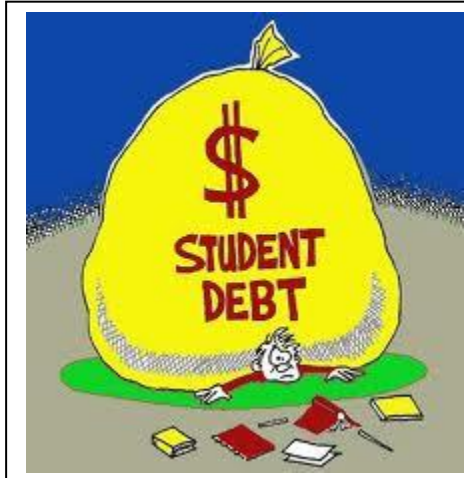




Hist 273: Labor & Economic History, 1877-2013
