2. Discussion Board: Your participation in this course is vital to the lively discussions that can ensue just from the challenging and poignant topics we will be covering! In this manner I gauge your participation in the course through your weekly responses to questions I pose on the course discussion board, as well as your responses/comments on other students' posts. Discussion postings are my way of also gauging your writing, so careful attention should be given to your responses (grammar, sentence structure, content, etc.) You may be asked to respond to a question I pose regarding one of the additional readings you are assigned or a video that you are asked to watch.
  - a. **Winter session courses and summer session course move fast. Winter session courses will have a discussion posting and responses every other day. Summer session courses will have a discussion posting and responses weekly to two sets of questions.**
