GETTING STARTED

Requirements & Computer Knowledge: Students must have access to a computer with an internet connection, an email account and the ability to download software. Chromebooks, tablets, and phones are not recommended as the primary device for online classes. Some courses may require the

use and/or download of various programs, which may include the use of proctored test exam monitoring software.

ACCESS TO CLASSES

Students will be loaded into Plato the weekend before the semester begins and will have access to a "Student Overview" course to get familiar with Plato. Students will see their Plato courses at 8 am on the first day of classes.

LATE REGISTRATON ACCESS TO CLASSES

Students registering through ADD/DROP will have access to their online courses in Plato within 24 hours from the time of registration. If you do not see your courses in Plato let your instructor know immediately.


