
WESTFIELD STATE UNIVERSITY HOUSING SELECTION

Current Students 2025-2026



- Housing Selection is an annual process for current students to select housing for the next academic year. Students can complete the housing agreement, confirm roommates, and select their room all from one easy online location.
- Selection is done through a lottery system. Students are issued a unique, randomly-generated selection time based on their class year. Class year is determined by the earned credit hours provided by the Registrar's Office. The process takes place online in the student's StarRez PortalX account, and students can access their account following these steps:



COMPLETING THE HOUSING AGREEMENT

- Selection times will start in the afternoon (1PM) instead of 5PM as in the past.
- To address needed repairs, parts of the Apartment Complex will be offline starting this summer.
 - ✓ Welch Hall: Closed Summer 2025 students expecting to move back early should not select Welch
 - ✓ Conlin Hall: Closed Fall 2025
 - Seymour Hall: Closed Spring 2026 Students selecting Seymour will be required to move to Conlin at the end of the semester
- Lammers Hall will be offline next year and not an option for housing

WHAT'S NEW?

- Students cannot select housing for matched roommates with lower a class year until those students are also eligible to participate in selection (e.g.: a rising junior cannot be pulled in by a rising senior on Selection Day 1 and must wait to select housing until Selection Day 2).
- Roommate groups that choose to select housing before all matched roommates are eligible <u>cannot</u> reserve open spaces in an apartment/suite for members of their group selecting on a night later in the process regardless of their matched roommate status.
- Students who want to select an individual space in a bedroom without filling the room can do so on Selection Day 4, April 7

HOW DOES SELECTION WORK?

- Students will not be required to submit their roommate group prior to a selection day. Students can make changes to their roommate group as often as they want/need. It is best to create your Web Name to make searching easier.
- Students will have the ability to partially fill an apartment or suite during selection. Any remaining spaces in that apartment or suite will be available immediately for other groups to select and cannot be held for students selecting on a later date.
- ALL students who want housing for the 2025-2026 academic year MUST select an available room during the selection process. <u>Students who do not select housing will not be assigned a room or billed for housing.</u>

GENERAL NOTES ABOUT SELECTION

- Students who have not selected housing will be issued a new selection time on each day of room selection until they have selected a room.
- Once a student selects housing (or has housing selected for them as part of a matched roommate group) they are committed to housing for the full academic year and would need to go through the Petition for Release process to request to be released from their Housing Agreement.

GENERAL NOTES ABOUT SELECTION



- Students who need housing during the academic year and break periods are able request additional information when completing the Housing Agreement. Those indicating interest will be contacted via email prior to selection to confirm if they would like to be assigned to the section and if they are approved for the section. Year-Round Housing communities will be located in New Hall (1st floor), and Davis Hall.
- Students needing housing during breaks are strongly encouraged to participate in Year-Round Housing to minimize relocation during break periods. Students assigned to Year- Round Housing will begin their assignment in August 2025 and, barring extenuating circumstances, will remain in that assignment through early August 2026.

YEAR-ROUND HOUSING

All student requests for reasonable housing accommodations based on a disability are reviewed and decided upon by the Banacos Academic Center. Students seeking a housing accommodation should request an appointment with their Banacos Advisor and complete a Reasonable Accommodations Request form. Accommodation requests will also require supporting documentation. REASONABLE HOUSING ACCOMMODATIONS

Students who need housing during the academic year and break periods will complete a 12-Month Housing Agreement. The Year-Round Housing community will be located on the 1st floor of New Hall.

 Students needing housing during breaks are strongly encouraged to participate in Year-Round Housing to minimize relocation during break periods.
 Students assigned to Year-Round Housing will begin their assignment in August 2025 and, barring extenuating circumstances, will remain in that assignment through early May 2026.

GENDER-INCLUSIVE HOUSING

- In order to be searchable in the system students my check the "Display in Roommate Search" box in the roommate profile page of the application.
- > You can only be a member of one group.
- > Once you send or accept a request, you will not be able to join any other group, but you can still add members to your group.
- > Once you send a request to a potential roommate, that person will need to accept your request in their application.
- > You can have a multi-gender roommate group.
- > Anyone in the group has the ability to add other members to the group.
- > You can leave a group at any time unless you are the group creator.
- > Any changes to the group will generate an email to students.




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ROOMMATE SEARCH BY PROFILES

- Gender and Age can also be used





SELECTION DAYS OVERVIEW

Students who want housing must select a room during housing selection to guarantee housing for the upcoming year.

Students who do not select a room will not be assigned for the Fall 2025 semester and will not be billed for housing or a dining plan.

YOU MUST SELECT A ROOM!

- At the end of the Housing Selection process, students who have not selected housing will not be assigned housing for the 2025-2026 academic year. No housing and dining charges will appear on the student's fall semester bill.

 the next steps the student must take.

APARTMENT COMPLEX: CONLIN & SEYMOUR HALLS

Conlin and Seymour Halls offer 6-person apartments with two double bedrooms and two single bedrooms. Conlin and Seymour house primarily juniors and seniors.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to building repairs, students will only be able to select into Seymour Hall for Fall 2025. Students with fall assignments in Seymour must move in December to the same assignment in Conlin Hall for Spring 2026.

- Private tower entrances minimize traffic

APARTMENT COMPLEX: WELCH HALL

Welch Hall houses primarily juniors and seniors with two towers of undergraduate students and two graduate towers. Welch offers 4-person apartments with two super single (i.e. double bedroom occupied by one student) rooms and two design single rooms.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to building repairs, Welch will NOT be open/available for summer students or students requesting early arrival in Fall 2025.

- Private living room, full kitchen, and $1 \frac{1}{2}$ bathrooms in each unit
- Detached laundry located at the Dickinson Hall annex
- Private tower entrances minimize traffic



COURTNEY HALL

Courtney Hall houses all first-year students in double bedrooms with a limited number of singles, triples, and quads. **Courtney will not be available during housing selection for rising sophomores, juniors, or seniors.*





Amenities:

- In-hall laundry service
- Elevator access
- 3 or more study lounges per floor
- Main lounge and kitchen located on the first floor

DAVIS HALL

Davis Hall houses all first-year students in double bedrooms with a limited number of singles, triples, and quads. Despite being on the opposite end of campus from Dickinson Hall, these halls share a similar footprint. *Davis will not be available during housing selection for rising sophomores, juniors, or seniors.





Amenities:

- In-hall laundry service
- Elevator access
- Three or more study lounges per floor
- Main lounge and kitchen located on the first floor

DICKINSON HALL

Dickinson Hall houses primarily sophomore students in double bedrooms with a limited number of singles, triples, and quads. Despite being on the opposite end of campus from Davis Hall, these halls share a similar footprint.





AMENITIES:

- In-hall laundry service
- Three or more study lounges per floor
- Main lounge and kitchen located on the first floor

NEW HALL

New Hall houses primarily juniors and seniors in 4-person and 6-person apartments. Each apartment has two single bedrooms and one or two double bedroom(s).





AMENITIES:

- Private living room, full kitchen, and 1-2 bathroom(s) in each unit
- Laundry service in hall
- Elevator access
- Air-conditioning
- In-hall common spaces for gathering and studying

UNIVERSITY HALL

University Hall houses sophomore, junior, and senior students in 4-person and 6-person suites. Most suites have double bedrooms, but a small number have two singles in place of one double.



AMENITIES:

•Private living room, full-sized refrigerator, and 1-2 bathroom(s) in each unit

•Laundry service in hall

•Elevator access

- •In-hall common spaces for gathering and studying
- •Full kitchen on each floor
