On Nov. 19, mandatory asymptomatic surveillance COVID-19 testing will be conducted for residential students remaining on the Westfield State University campus during the “Critical Operations Only Curtailment/shelter-in-place” period. Voluntary asymptomatic COVID-19 testing for employees with an on-ground presence during this period will also be held on this date, in The Woodward Center. STUDENTS

Residential Students:

Mandatory asymptomatic surveillance COVID-19 testing **for ONLY residential students who have been approved by Housing Operations to remain on campus during the “Critical Operations Only Curtailment/shelter-in-place” period** will be on the following day:

EMPLOYEES

Asymptomatic surveillance COVID-19 testing will be conducted for employees who have an on-campus presence during the “Critical Operations Only Curtailment/shelter-in-place” period. Employee testing is voluntary, but those with an on-campus presence—particularly those interacting with students—are strongly encouraged to participate in the testing program.
