Description The Substance Abuse Counselor will work within the Community Based Integrated Team serving Persons served in the Adult Community Clinical Services (ACCS). The Substance Abuse Counselor will help develop treatment plans, provide interventions that address issues of substance use and sobriety, develop and implement relapse prevention plans, provide education and counseling on addiction and the disease process, and assist Persons with accessing substance use treatment services including inpatient/residential treatment, detoxification programs, intensive outpatient services, self-help and 12 step groups.

Requirements Certification or certification eligible as an addictions counselor, CADC, LADC II, or LADC I, Master's Degree preferred, and experience in a mental health and/or substance use treatment program. Must be available to provide outreach services and work flexible schedule to best meet needs of Persons served.
