As a Clinical Supervisor, you will:

- Provide psycho-social assessments for assigned clients

Requirements are as follows:

- Required license (LICSW, LMHC OR LMFT).
- Preferred three years' supervisory experience.
- Nonjudgmental ability to foster self-sufficiency using problem-solving and practical skills.
- Ability to establish trusting relationships through compassion, empathy and insight.
- Demonstrated sensitivity to the needs of clients from diverse cultural or linguistic backgrounds.
- Bilingual/bicultural Spanish-speaking candidates are encouraged to apply.
