- Additionally, applicant must be able and willing to work in a team, which is culturally diverse and operates from a community strength-based model.
- Maintains all appropriate records and adheres to organizational policies.
- Adheres to organizational policies and procedures. Meets productivity standards. Contributes to Performance Improvement activities when indicated to improve areas within clinical practice, or systems issues effecting delivery of service.

- Master's Degree, **(60 credit minimum)**, in Psychology, Social Work, Counseling, or related Mental Health field from an accredited program.
- Required license eligibility: **LICSW, LMHC OR LMFT**
- Bilingual/bicultural Spanish-speaking are highly encouraged to apply.
- Proficient in Microsoft Office and computer literate required.
- Time management skills required.
- A current Massachusetts CANS certification an asset.
- Reliable transportation
- Nonjudgmental ability to foster self-sufficiency using problem-solving and practical skills.
