If you have a passion for helping individuals to achieve mental health recovery and more fulfilling lives in the community, this position is an excellent opportunity.

You will provide community-based outreach social work services. You will collaborate with colleagues and organizations in the community that provide mental health and substance use treatment, as well as a range of social, economic, educational, and vocational services, ACCS values working together to support each program participant in meeting his or her unique goals and needs.

As an **Outreach Counselor**, you will:

- Assist people in achieving their treatment plan goals through case management.
- Provide help in securing benefits and other resources.
- Provide support and education for participants to improve their community living skills including help with the following:
 - Transportation: accompanying people to appointments and teaching them to use public transportation
 - Provide coaching and support related to mastering activities of daily living.
 - Provide help obtaining services and navigating complex systems of care.
 - Contribute as part of the clinical team to inform ongoing service planning.
 - Provide emotional support, encouragement, and mentorship.
