This position is predominantly campus-based work with some outreach and home-based work as well with a low caseload.

The successful candidate will be positive, outgoing, enthusiastic, patient, flexible, and creative. Must possess strong organizational skills, and be self-motivated. Candidates should have a positive attitude with strong verbal & written communications skills, ability to establish clear professional boundaries, and personal values. All candidates must complete and pass background record screening process and have a clean driving record. Reliable transportation required. Master's degree required; LICSW/LMHC preferred. Bilingual candidates are encouraged to apply.
