As a member of the care team, you'd help prepare meals, clean, do laundry, and help keep the home pleasant and comfortable. You'd also complete daily reports about residents' progress, and would help assure their safety around the clock.

TRAINING AND QUALIFICATIONS

We provide the same level of care in our homes that we'd want for anyone we love. We pay for your orientation and training to obtain certification in First Aid, CPR, the Medication Administration Program (MAP), and Applied Non-Violence. Other requirements of the job include:

- A passion for working with people who are living with a disability.
- Previous experience with brain injuries preferred.
- CNA/PCA experience a plus!
- Basic computer skills.
- Physical ability to perform the requirements of this position.
- A valid driver's license and acceptable motor vehicle record.
