## ENGLISH CLUB CONSTITUTION

## Article I

Name:
The name of this organization shall be the Westfield state College English Club.

## Article II

## Purpose:

The purpose of this club shall be:

1. To cultivate the appreciation of literature and other arts.
2. To provide opportunities for the enrichment among students.
3. Management and production of the literary magazine "Persona".

## Article III

## Membership:

Membership shall be open to all matriculated students of the college who have paid their student activities fee for the current semester.

## Article IV

## Officers:

Section One: Officers shall be President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.
Section Two: Qualifications for officers shall be:
A. All officers must be matriculated students at WSC.
B. The Secretary shall be required to give each member of the organization a copy of the Constitution and its amendments.
C. The Secretary shall be responsible for notifying members of all regular meetings.

Section Three: Duties of the Treasurer.
A. The Treasurer shall keep records of all monies of the organization and shall be required to report at each regular meeting as to the amount of the monies.

Section Four: All current members of the club are eligible to hold office.
Section Five: The term of each office will run from May ${ }^{\text {st }}$ of one year until April $31^{\text {st }}$ of the following year (one year terms).

## Article V

## Meetings:

Meetings must be held at least once each month throughout the academic year.

## Article VI

## Faculty Advisor:

The Faculty Advisor for the organization shall be a faculty member of Westfield State College, chosen by a majority vote of the members.

## Article VII

## Management of "Persona":

Section One: "Persona: shall be run by a board of five to seven editors of equal status.
Section Two: Nomination of Editors
A. Editors shall be selected by nomination and two-thirds majority vote.
B. Editors shall be voted upon in December.

Section Three: Acquisitions of Monies
A. President, Vice-President, and Treasurer of the English Club must go to Senate meetings for allocation of funds.
B. Secretary and Treasurer will work together towards the completion of the proposal of "Persona".
