



Clinical Social Worker Bowdoin Street Health Center

Bowdoin Street Health Center seeks a Clinical Social Worker to join our Neighborhood Trauma Team (NTT) Network. The NTT's mission is to provide immediate to long-term care for individuals who experienced trauma due to violence in the community. The Clinical Social Worker for this team will help to facilitate community coping/healing groups, assist with community outreach to distribute basic trauma health information, provide trauma education and support at community meetings, and offer ongoing behavioral health services for individuals and families. The Clinical Social Worker will also provide direct clinical services to clients, including psychosocial assessment, treatment planning, short and long-term therapy, group therapy, and substance abuse counseling for adults and children. Clinical work will help clients address a range of personal issues and life events, including coming out, coping with self-esteem issues, seeking more satisfying relationships, living with HIV, addressing substance use or other addictive behaviors, coping with depression and anxiety, grieving the death of a loved one, coping with and recovering from violence, living with major mental illness. As assigned, the Clinical Social Worker partners with other community agencies to provide consultation, in-service education and assistance in case finding.

This is a grant-funded position as part of the Boston Public Health Commission's Neighborhood Trauma Team (NTT) Network.

The Bowdoin Street Health Center is a multi-specialty practice serving the Bowdoin-Geneva community of Boston. We provide comprehensive primary care, behavioral health services, and several specialty care services. Our behavioral health department is highly collaborative and is very committed to meeting patient needs. In addition, the behavioral health department is fully integrated within the health center as a whole and there is ample opportunity for close collaboration with the primary care providers.

Founded in Boston's Dorchester neighborhood in 1972 by community residents, <u>Bowdoin Street Health</u> <u>Center</u> remains focused on providing outstanding medical care while maintaining a tradition of working with residents to identify and meet their unique health needs. The health center's mission is to provide excellent, compassionate care to our patients and support the health of the entire community.

Recognizing how social and economic factors in the community can also influence an individual's health status, Bowdoin Street actively engages with community organizations and public entities to prevent violence, improve access to healthy, affordable foods and promote wellness through exercise and stress reduction.
