

## Financial Interest in Instructional Materials: Faculty Disclosure to State Ethics Commission

Checklist for Completing the Disclosure Form

The State Ethics Commission has determined that pursuant to G.L. c. 268A, §6, prior to assigning any instructional material in which they have a financial interest, a faculty member must file a written disclosure and receive a written determination from the Vice President of Academic Affairs indicating the financial interest is not so substantial as to constitute a violation of the conflict of interest law.
