OBJECTIVES: The emphasis of the course is to provide both basic and practical design applications combining online lectures, reviewing artwork in a two-dimensional format. These concepts will be discussed in how they apply to the arts, as well as our everyday surroundings. The basic design principles can then be used as a foundation for all students' works of art.

ALL STUDENTS will be graded on an individual basis, rather than on a curve. This course DOES NOT require drawing skills to successfully complete this online class. It is about learning the fundamental CONCEPTS of design theory. Text will be recommended, not required.

ASSIGNMENTS AND LECTURES will be given and graded on each lecture provided for the student online. Students will be required to participate in online discussions in the Plato/Vista format.

This course will fulfill an ARTS & APPRECIATION requirement and a ART CORE requirement.
