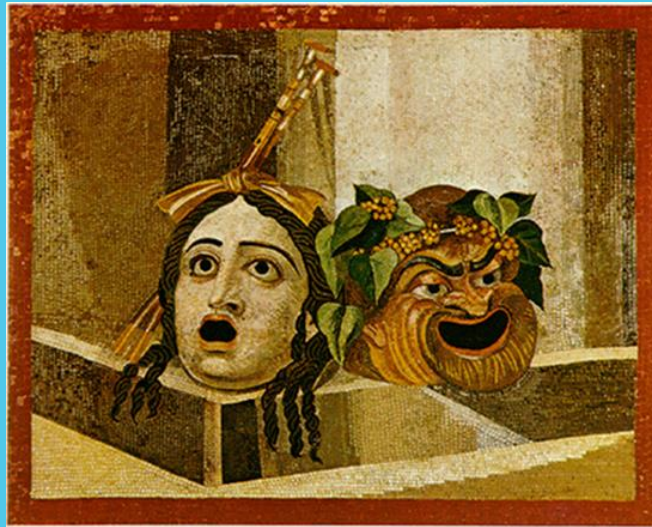


THEA 0104-005: Introduction to Theatre

Asynchronous Online Course Fall 2020 (3 credits)

This course is designed to acquaint students with the origins & nature of theatre within historical periods. Students will learn the theory & practice of the theatre arts, including its history, as well as aspects of dramatic theory, directing, playwriting, acting, & design. Students will acquire tools with which to experience, analyze, & appreciate the theatrical experience, whether as audience members, participants in the production, or by simply reading a script.



All readings will be uploaded to Plato

The course will include weekly discussion forums, quizzes, video and reading content, weekly play reading reflections, individual creative projects, and final and mid-term essay projects.

Students will be required to attend the Theatre Arts Program's virtual production running November 18th-21st.
